## Mark 1:35-39

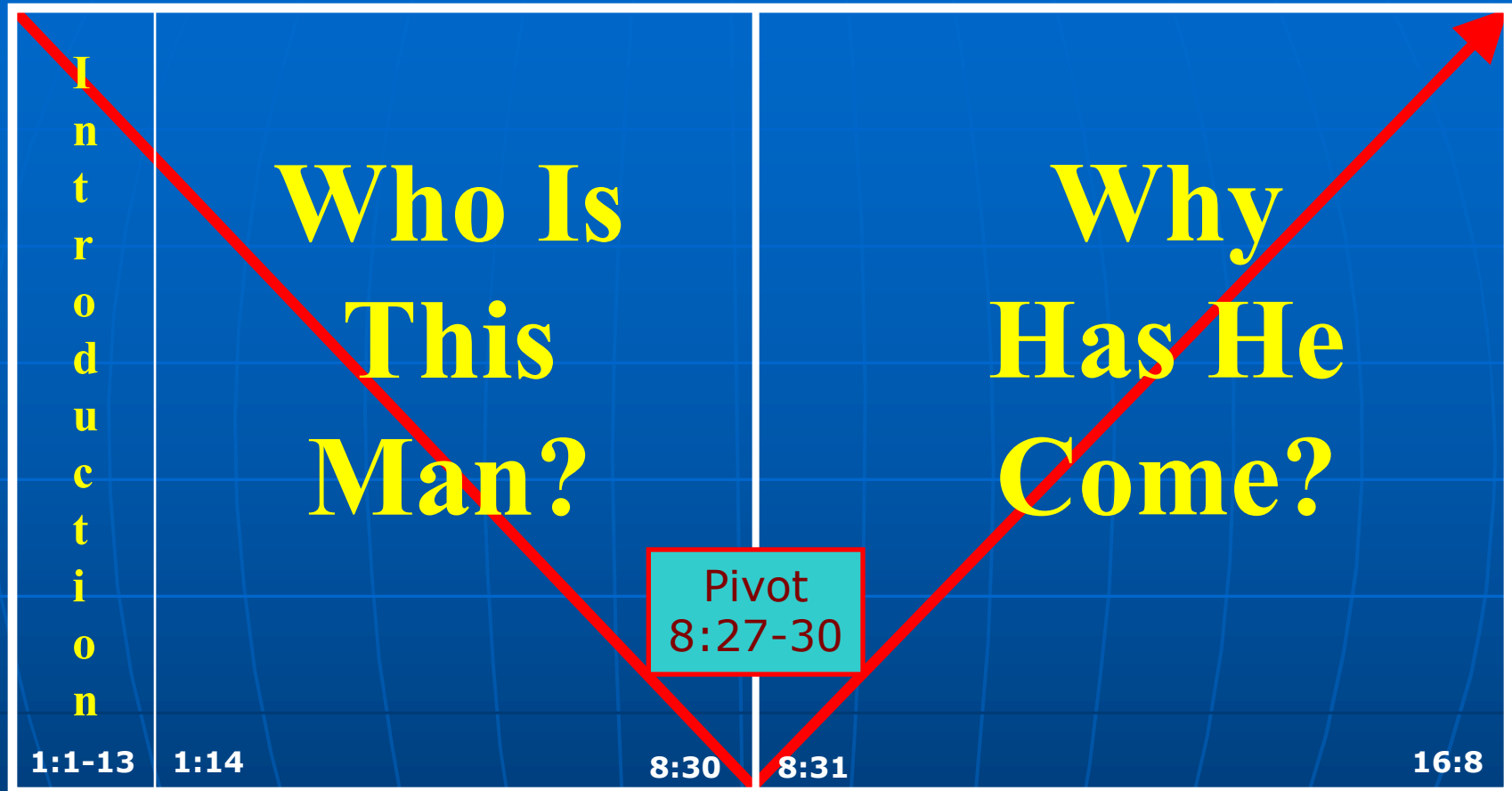
<sup>35</sup> Very early in the morning, while it was still dark, Jesus got up, left the house and went off to a **solitary place**, where he prayed.

## Mark 1:35-39

<sup>36</sup> Simon and his companions went to look for him,<sup>7</sup> and when they found him, they exclaimed: "Everyone is looking for you!"<sup>38</sup> Jesus replied, "Let us go somewhere else-- to the nearby villages-- so I can preach there also. **That is why I have come.**"

<sup>39</sup> So he traveled throughout Galilee, preaching in their synagogues and driving out demons.

## Mark 8:22-26

<sup>22</sup> They came to Bethsaida, and some people brought a blind man and begged Jesus to touch him. <sup>23</sup> He took the blind man by the hand and led him outside the village. When he had spit on the man's eyes and put his hands on him, Jesus asked, "Do you see anything?" <sup>24</sup> He looked up and said, "I see people; they look like trees walking around."

## Mark 8:22-26

<sup>25</sup> Once more Jesus put his hands on the man's eyes. Then his eyes were opened, his sight was restored, and he saw everything clearly.

<sup>26</sup> Jesus sent him home, saying, "Don't even go into the village."

## Mark 8:27-30

Jesus and his disciples went on to the villages around **Caesarea Philippi**.

**On the way** he asked them, "Who do people say I am?" They replied, "Some say John the Baptist; others say Elijah; and still others, one of the prophets."

"But what about you?" he asked. "Who do you say I am?"

Peter answered, "You are the Christ."

Jesus **warned them not to tell anyone about him**.

## 1<sup>st</sup> Passion Prediction

<sup>31</sup> He then began to teach them that the Son of Man must suffer many things and be rejected by the elders, the chief priests and the teachers of the law, and that he must be killed and after three days rise again.

<sup>32</sup> He spoke plainly about this, and Peter took him aside and began to rebuke him.

## 1<sup>st</sup> Passion Prediction

<sup>33</sup> But when Jesus turned and looked at his disciples, he rebuked Peter.

"Get behind me, Satan!" he said. "You do not have in mind the concerns of God, but merely human concerns."



## 2<sup>nd</sup> Passion Prediction – 9:30-34

<sup>30</sup> They left that place and passed through Galilee. Jesus did not want anyone to know where they were, <sup>31</sup> because he was teaching his disciples. He said to them, "The Son of Man is going to be delivered into the hands of men. They will kill him, and after three days he will rise."

<sup>32</sup> But they did not understand what he meant and were afraid to ask him about it.

## 2<sup>nd</sup> Passion Prediction – 9:30-34

<sup>33</sup> They came to Capernaum. When he was in the house, he asked them, "What were you arguing about on the road?"

<sup>34</sup> But they kept quiet because on the way they had argued about who was the greatest.

## 3<sup>rd</sup> Passion Prediction – 10:32-35

32 They were on their way up to Jerusalem, with Jesus leading the way, and the disciples were astonished, while those who followed were afraid. Again he took the Twelve aside and told them what was going to happen to him.

## 3<sup>rd</sup> Passion Prediction – 10:32-35

<sup>33</sup> "We are going up to Jerusalem," he said, "and the Son of Man will be delivered over to the chief priests and the teachers of the law. They will condemn him to death and will hand him over to the Gentiles, <sup>34</sup> who will mock him and spit on him, flog him and kill him. Three days later he will rise."

## 3<sup>rd</sup> Passion Prediction – 10:32

<sup>35</sup> Then James and John, the sons of Zebedee, came to him. "Teacher," they said, "we want you to do for us whatever we ask."
